

UPDATE FROM MOSES MAKANTA

Dear praying friends,

Greetings.

The radio ministry has continued to impact many lives in the country with calls to plant churches in Luapula Province of Zambia. In the past I mentioned about a church that was started in Mwansabombwe as a result of the same radio program. Again in the recent past, I mentioned about a group of people in Milenge, in the same province, that has continued meeting at someone's residence every Saturday to listen to my program and that they have requested me to go and meet and conduct teachings on the gospel of grace with them.

The last weekend, I received a phone call from another listener by the name of Samson Chanda of Chiengi district in the same province. He was requesting me to go and conduct teachings on salvation with him and the group in the district. Samson is one of the members of the Chiefs Council in his chiefdom. He and many others have been following my preaching on the radio for quite sometime now. He told me that he and a group of about 40 others who meet every Saturday under a very big tree that is within the area to listen to my radio program. At the end of the program, they discuss the message and pray before they disperse. One day, as he was listening to the program, Samson said, the Lord touched him. He felt convicted of his sin and that he had tried with his own strength to serve himself but he had failed. He was shocked to discover that, Jesus came to die on the cross for him to receive eternal forgiveness that gives him the assurance of entering heaven. As he continued to listen to God's word through my program, Samuel started feeling uncomfortable to remain a member of the Chiefs' Council which met to worship the spirits of the dead with the chief and his fellow council members. He requested me

for help in that regard. Thankfully after spending the last two days with him on the phone, Samson is now free from this demonic bondage. God has changed his life.

His wife has also embraced the gospel of grace. According to him, he and his wife are among the many others who have been meeting under a big tree to listen to my messages being played on the radio. The last time they met, they agreed that they will provide food for me and any other people that I might want to travel with. I told him to give me sometime to see if I can manage to raise money for transport for myself, my wife and two others. This means that if the Lord wills that I go, I will not only end in Chiengi. I will also need to use that opportunity to reach to Mwansabombwe and Milenge and conduct teachings with them.

I have continued to receive many calls on a daily basis from various listeners countrywide. Most of them ask me to help them about how they can be sure of their salvation. This has been keeping me very busy being in the presence of God studying his word and praying.

During the midmonth of July, I was in Ndola for another module in the year for my degree program. I have assignments on the Pastoral theology which I need to submit when I go back for the next module on 20th September. Please keep praying for me for this.

The college that wrote to offer me an honorary degree during their graduation ceremony to take place this year in November in recognition for my commitment to radio ministry, called me again to invite me for an interview in Kabwe in readiness for the graduation, but I still declined. My interest is not in a title, but in total commitment to service for the Lord.

- Please pray for God's provision for me to go to these places. My prayer is that if the Lord wills that I go, I should be able to spend some good time with each of these groups for the purpose of giving them more teachings on the gospel of grace.

- Also pray for God's provision of Bibles which they requested me to bring. They are willing to buy Bibles. The challenge that they have is, they do not have a place where they can find a Bible to buy.
- Pray that God will continue to touch many more lives for them to be saved as I do ministry on the radio
- Thank you once again for the continued support to this ministry. I have always been very grateful to God for you. I wish you God's abundant blessings in Jesus' name.
